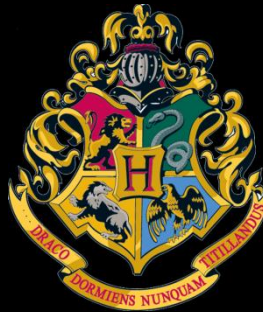

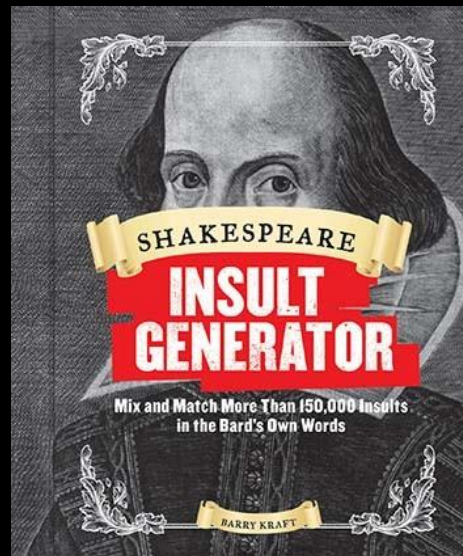

If you ever have a need to bring a huge crowd into your library, throw a Doctor Who party. Trust us. And then RUN!

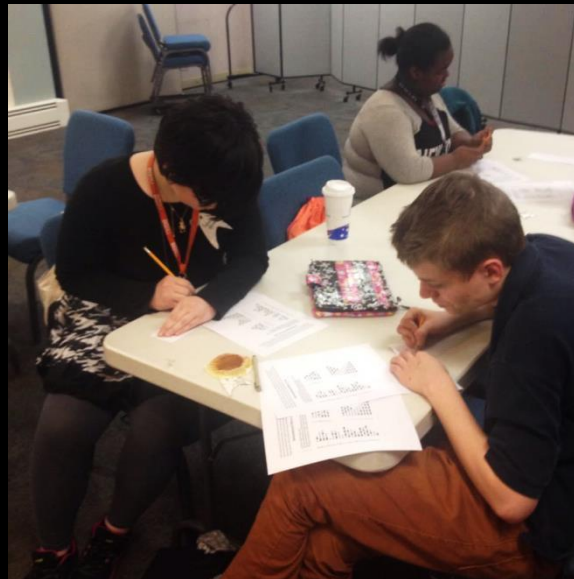

The Hunger Games

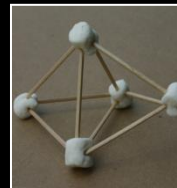
Just one movie left! Will we survive the Hunger Games after all?

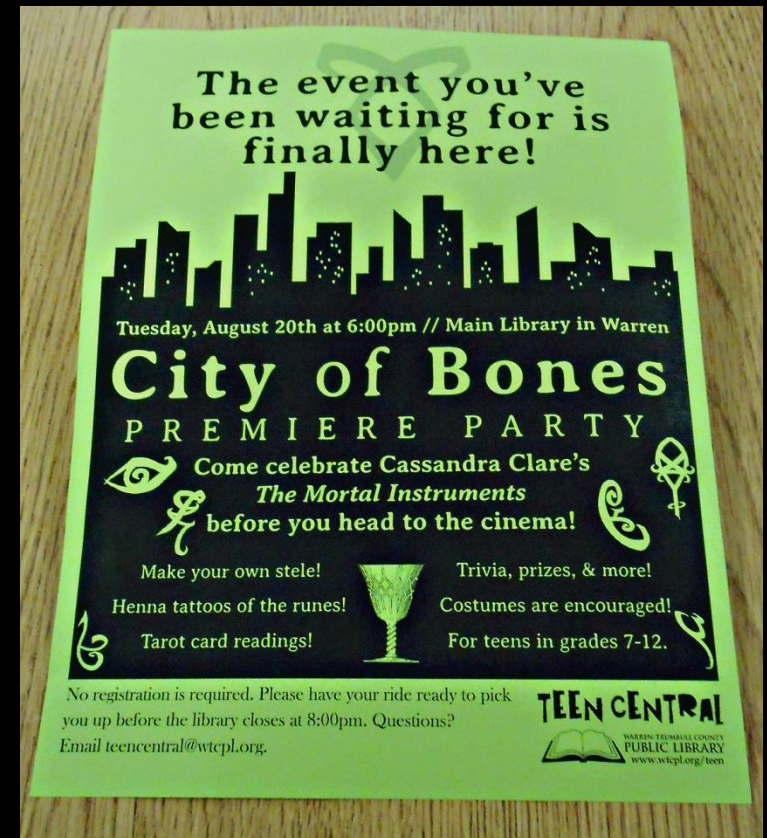
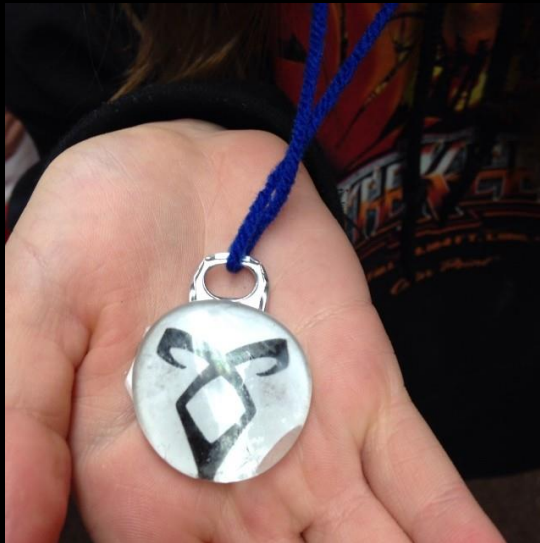

- Mystery Kit - Rikki made one! Email her.

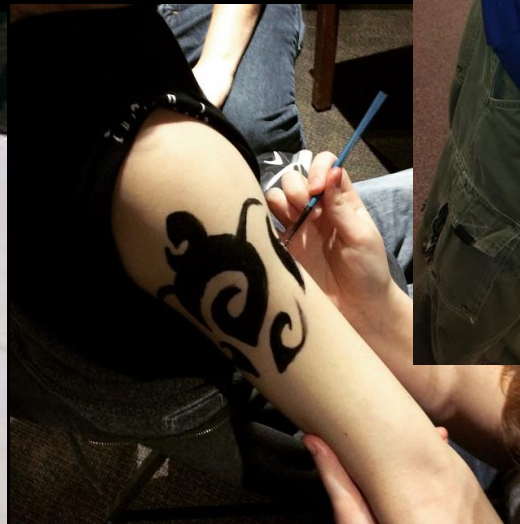
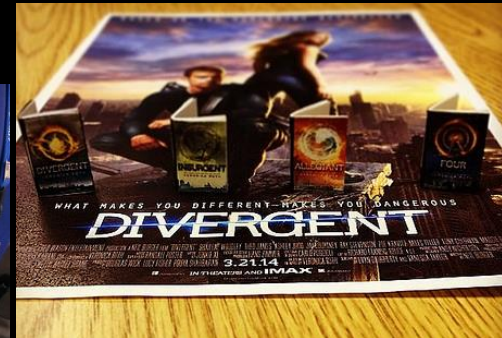

Two movies down, two to go! Do something for each faction...

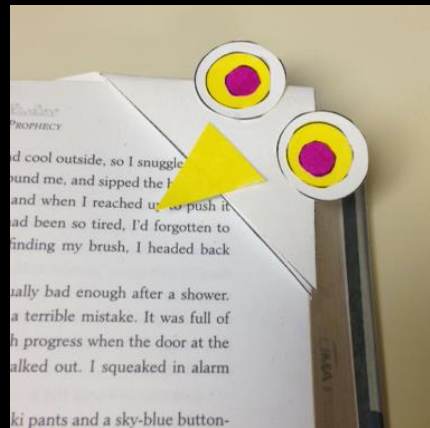
- Rubber band bracelets with faction colors
