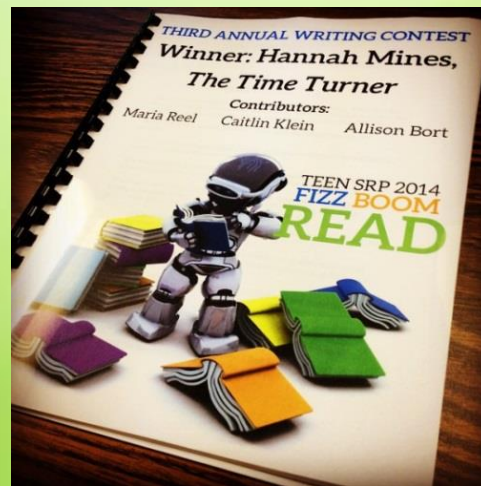
# Social Media
